




# Anti-Bullying

This policy looks at bullying, and what you can do when you feel you are being bullied, or when you notice someone else being bullied.

## What is bullying?

Repeated behaviour which is intended to hurt someone either emotionally or physically.

At our school, we use the word 'STOP' to distinguish bullying from one-off incidents or accidents.




**Physical** - hitting, kicking, spitting or threatening to do this things.

**Verbal** - name calling, teasing, using rude language or saying nasty things about someone to them or other people.

**Emotional** - Ignoring someone, hurting feelings, leaving someone out on purpose and encouraging others to do so.

**Online** - sending hurtful or unkind comments or videos to someone or about someone via messaging or social media platforms.

We will all work together to S.T.O.P bullying.


